balloons in it?

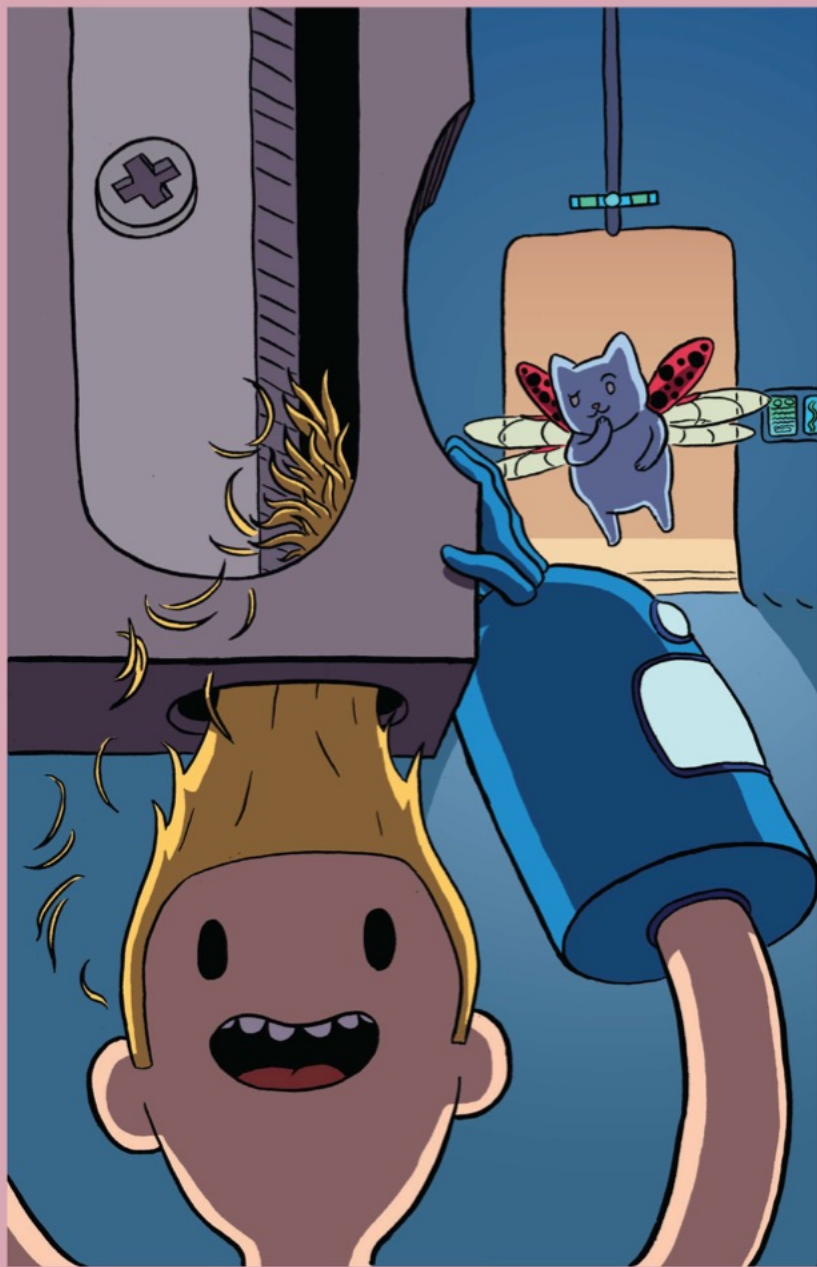


Me & Slippy Napkins
