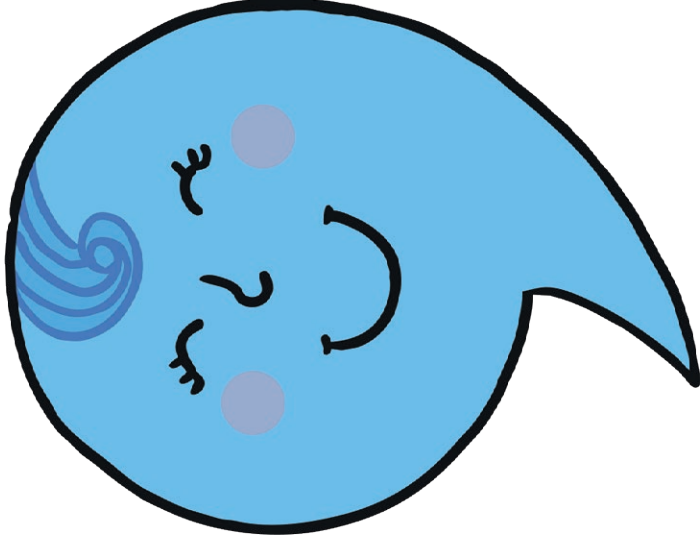


Commas



A Comma separates units of meaning in a sentence.

A comma connects items in a list

A comma separates items in a list.

pears for her fruit salad.

A comma separates off a subordinate opening.

Although she was tired, Tilly went to the party .

**A comma marks out a relative clause (extra
information that has been added into
the sentence).**
