6. What sounds might you hear in this picture? Can you make some of the sounds and see if your friend can guess what they are?
7. Imagine you are a garda. What advice or tips would you give to drivers and cyclists as they travel during the storm?
8. What type of clothing might people need to wear if they had to go outside in this type of weather?
9. Can you think of a word that describes clothing and equipment that doesn't allow the water into it?
10. What season do you think this picture might be set in? Give reasons for your answer.
11. List some words that mean something is wet.
12. Imagine you are a weather reporter on the local radio. Give a quick weather report about the storm including some of the words and language you have already used.
