- 9. When might people give flowers and plants as presents?
- 10. What things do plants and flowers need to grow?
- 11. Apart from gardens, where else might you see flowers and plants?
- 12. What other creatures and living things might live in a place like the one shown in the picture?
- 13. Can you think of some rules the teacher might have for the children to follow when they are visiting and working in the garden? Give reasons why these rules are important.





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
