

Personal and Possessive Pronouns **Answers**

A **pronoun** is a word used in place of a noun.
example: **Juan** read a story. **He** enjoyed the story.

A **possessive pronoun** shows who or what owns something.
example: The dog is **mine**. This book is **yours**. The cat is **hers**.
