Any item that's normally in an office can come along.



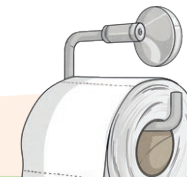

Any item that's a fruit can come along.

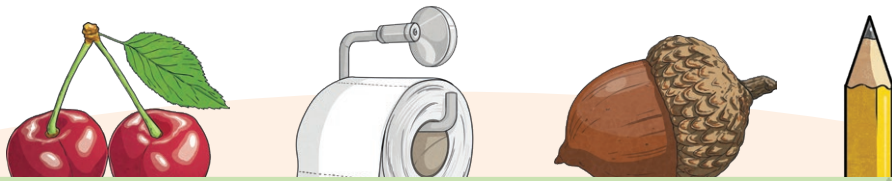

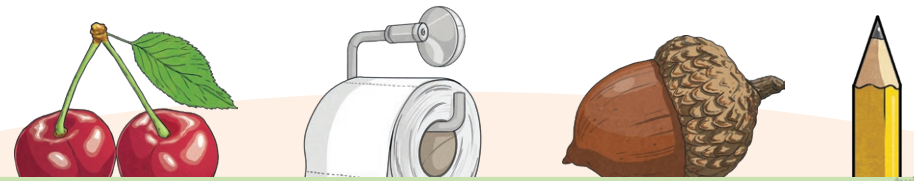

(example: cheese, apple, orange)



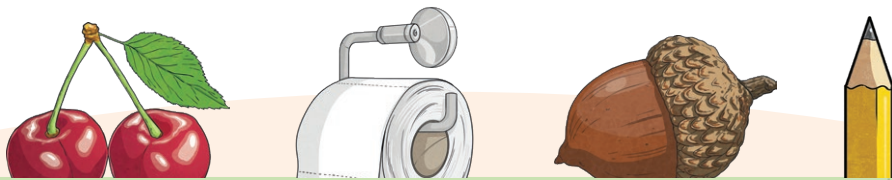

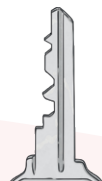
I'm Going on Vacation - Hard

Any item said by players wearing black can come along.



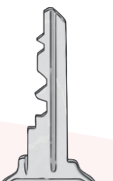
I'm Going on Vacation - Hard

Any item that is two syllables can come along.



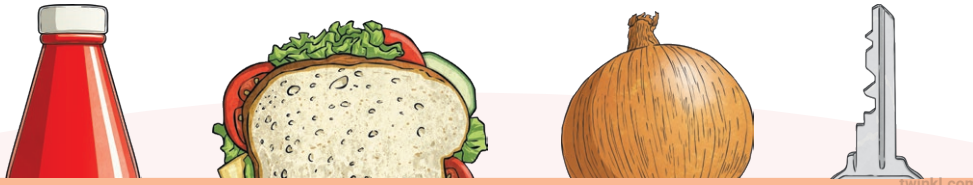
I'm Going on Vacation - Hard

Any uncountable nouns can come along.

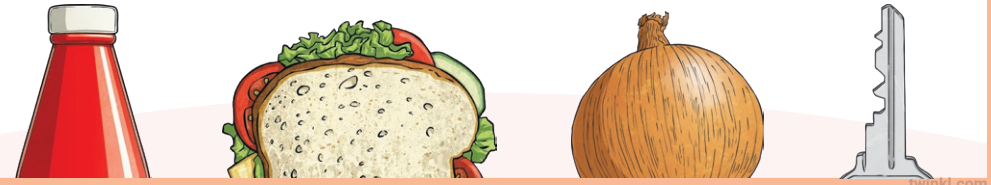


Any items that start with the same letter as the player can come along.

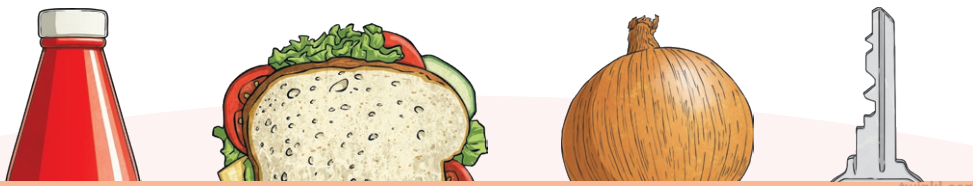
(example: Janet can bring **juice**,
Sam can bring **sandwiches**.)



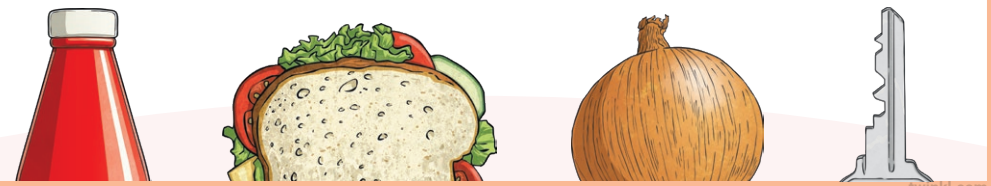
Any item that is lighter than a pound can come along.



Any item that grows in the ground can come along.

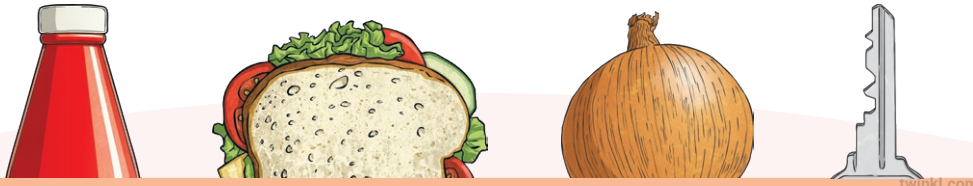


Any item that contains metal can come along.



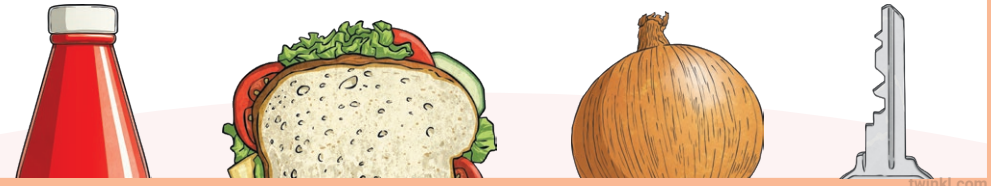

Any item that you can use at a swimming pool can come along.



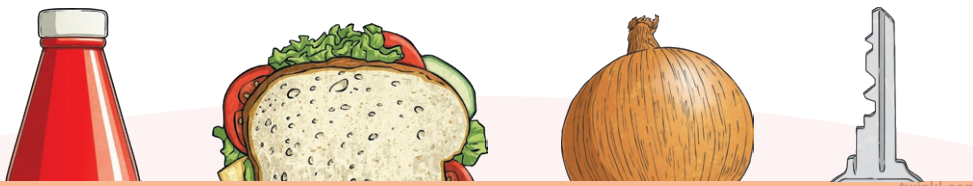

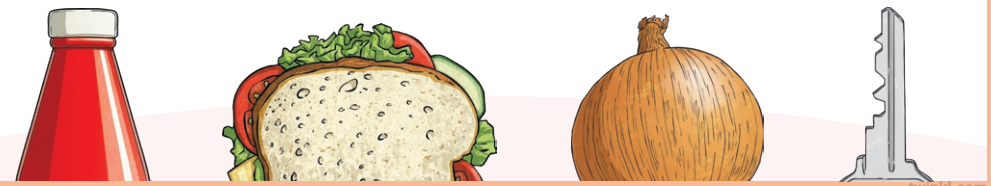
Any item that you can find in a classroom can come along.
