Teacher Instructions:

This document contains 4 unique worksheets. Each student only needs one page from this document.

Once you have handed out the worksheets, explain that the students should try to find people who fit the description provided in each prompt. They should write the name of the student and a detail of the interaction.



This resource has been made for the purpose of teaching English language learners. We know that students can be learning English in many different places, in many different ways and at age, so we try to keep these resources as general as possible. There are many acronyms associated with English language teaching. These include (but are not limited to) ELT, TEFL, EFL, ELL, EAL and ESOL.
