

This lesson is the fifth in a set of twelve lessons for English language beginners. It has been designed with online teachers in mind, but you can use it in any setting where you are able to share your screen.

This lesson places focus on dreams and aspirations and introduces the focal questions of "What do you want to be?" and "What do you want to do?". ESL students will have the opportunity to learn about different professions as well as what each profession entails.

Your students may not be able to understand the instructions, so use them as a guide to help you explain to your students what they need to do. To help we've included visual clues to help them understand how to engage with this lesson.

You can repeat this lesson if needed, and we've also included links to other resources you may want to use for additional practice. Lesson number six and twelve will also be review lessons that will recap all of the dialogue and vocabulary from this lesson.
