Comma - in a sentence it separates units of meaning

COMMAS MATTER

I like eating my dog and LEGO.
I like eating, my dog and LEGO.

Separates items in a list

Jenna bought some apples, grapes, bananas and pears for her fruit salad.

Separating off an introductory 'chunk'

Although she was tired, Tilly went to the party.

Marks out an embedded clause (extra information added into the sentence)

The children, who were in class six, were very excited.
