

Editable Grammar Auction Instructions

Welcome to the grammar auction! Today, we will be selling off sentences to the highest bidding student or group. The winner is the group/student who has bought the most correct sentences at the end!

1. Choose your currency, then print off and cut up as much 'money' as you need. Each group should have 100 pounds/dollars, so if you have three groups, print off three pages.
2. Divide students into groups.
3. Allocate 100 pounds/dollars to each group.
4. Explain to students that the group with the most correct sentences at the end of the game wins - not the group with the most money.
5. Give each group the full sheet of sentences to correct. They must write down the correct sentence in full.
6. Tell students that they can 'bid' for sentences. The group that bids the most for a sentence will 'buy' it. However, they can only keep the sentence if they have corrected it accurately.
7. Auction off the sentences one by one, collecting money from the students who bid the most. Give students a point only when their sentence is correct.
8. At the end of the game, see which group bought the most correct sentences - they are the winners!

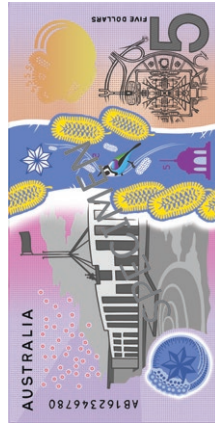
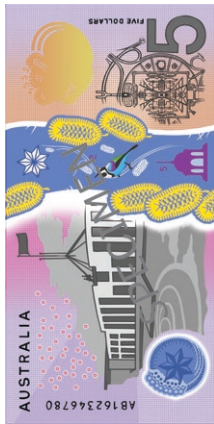
Play Money
