What do you think they'll do when they finish their picnic?

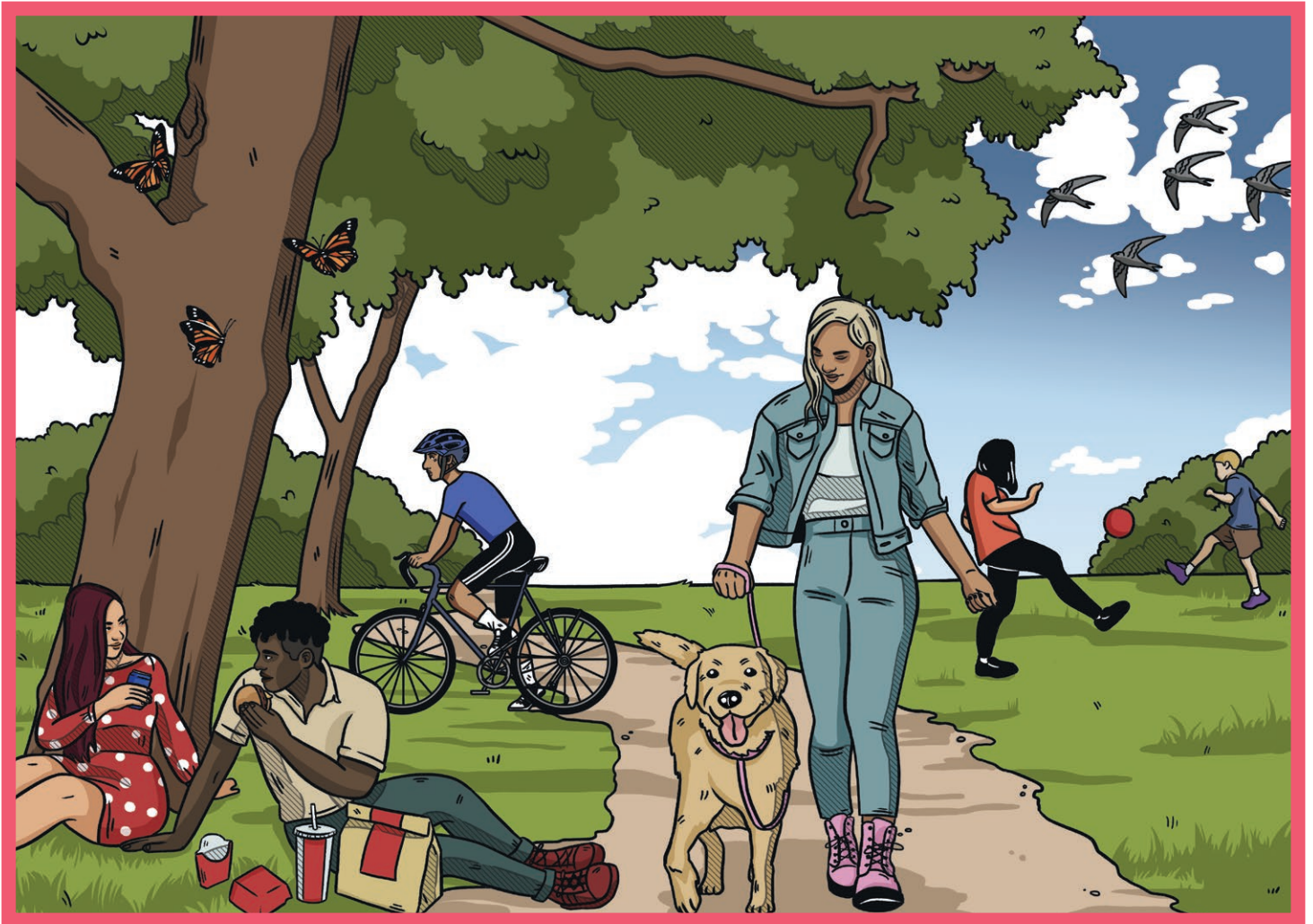
If you move to a new town, what's a good way to make new friends?

What are the people in the picture doing?

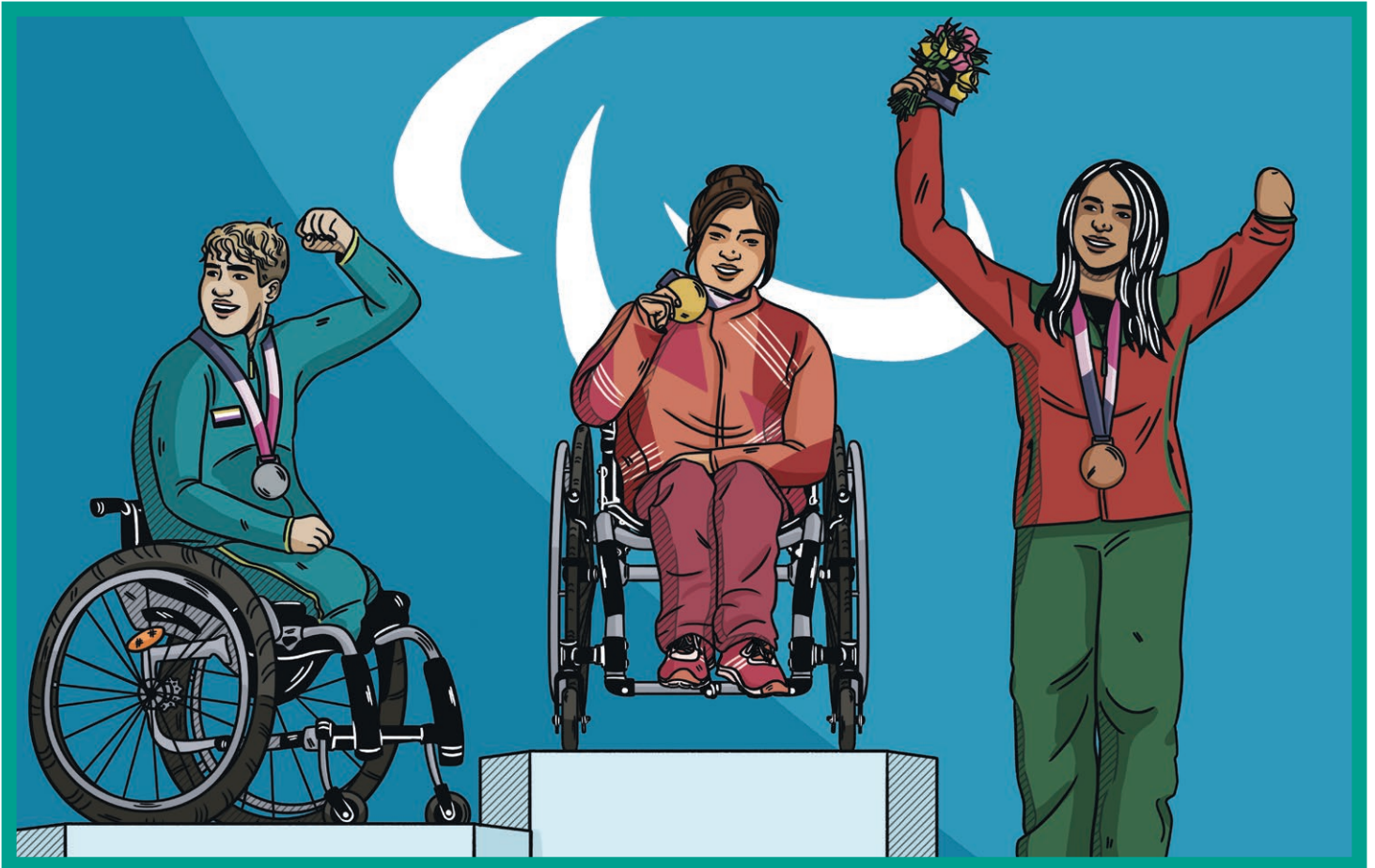
What objects can you see?
