

Simple Present Tense

We use the simple present tense when we are writing about something that is **repeated**, is **always true** or is happening in a **future time**.



Repeated

Eva wakes up at half past seven every morning.

I walk to school.

I ride my bike every weekend.

Always or generally true

The sun sets in the west.

I speak Urdu.

They live in a city.

Happening in a future time

The bus leaves at 9 o'clock.

The film starts at half past three.
