In the evening, I visit my mum, and go on a walk with my dog. Then I put on my pyjamas and watch my favourite film - my superhero film!



Hello, my name is Hana. Welcome to my city!


I live in a small city in Japan. My city's name is Otaru. It's next to the sea. There are big mountains in Otaru where you can go skiing, so there's always something fun to do.



On Wednesday, I went to the cinema with my friends. We saw a really funny film and we ate a lot of popcorn. After the film, I helped my mum and dad in the garden.




