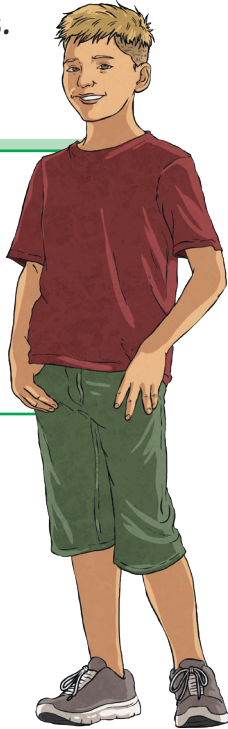


Level 1: My Friends

Hello! These are my friends.

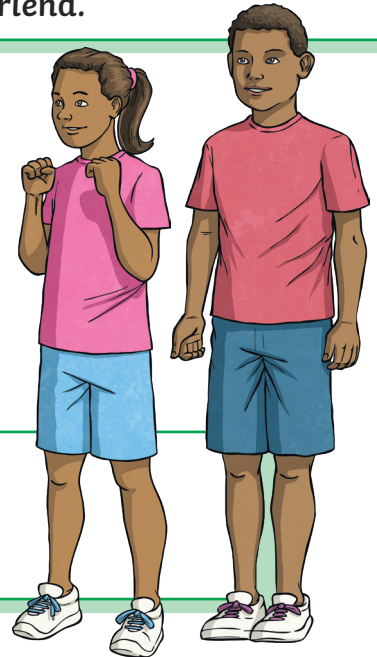
This is Joe. Joe is 13 years old. He's from the USA but his mum is from Brazil. He's really nice and very tall.

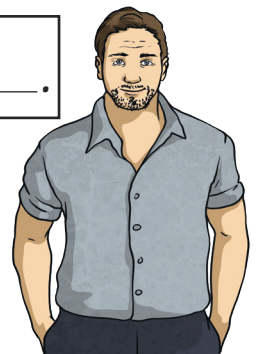

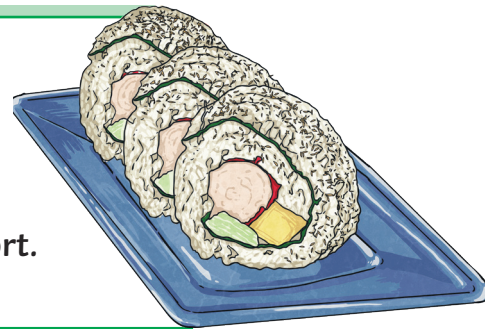
Hello, my name is Hana. Welcome to my city!

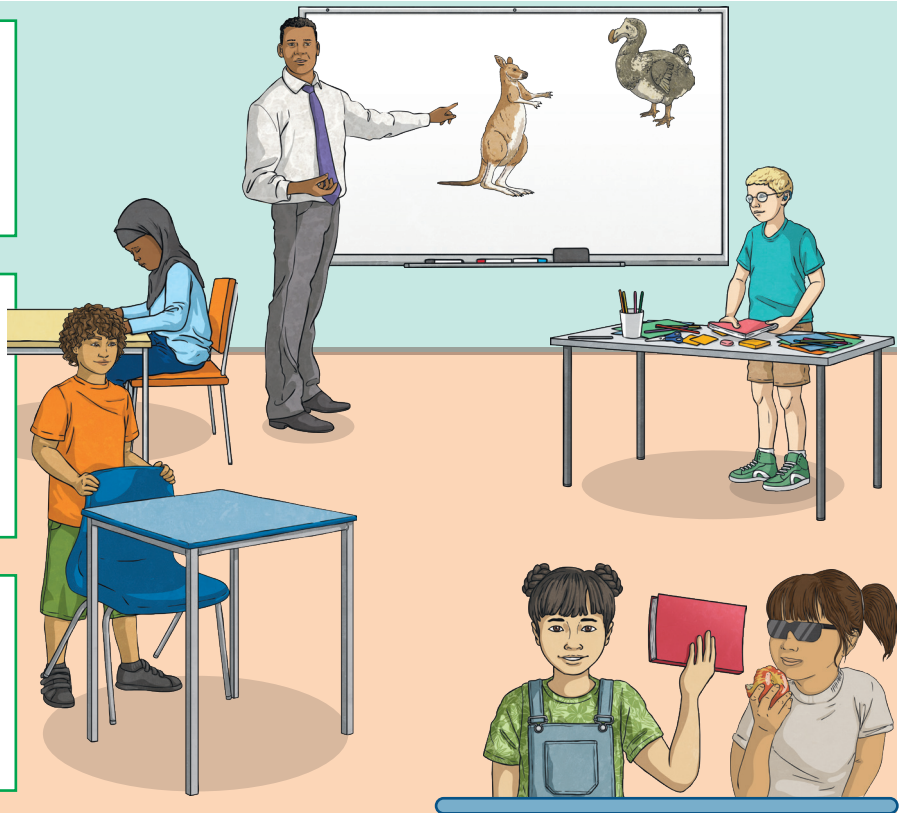

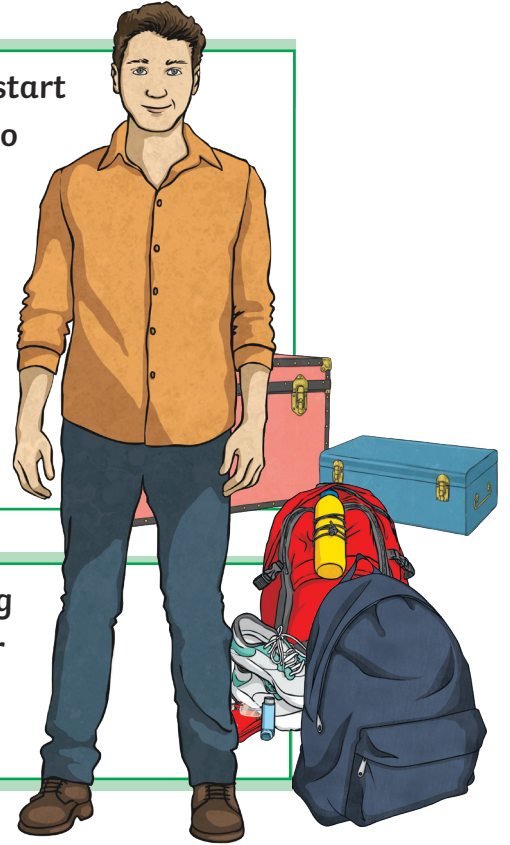
Level 6: My University
