Question	Suggested Answers	
What will happen next?	The mum will place the cake on the table, the children will sing 'Happy Birthday' and the birthday boy will blow out the candles.	
How do you think he feels? (adult to point to the boy celebrating his birthday)	Happy because it's his birthday, his friends are at his party and he has a smile on his face. or Excited because it's his birthday, his friends are at his party and he is waving his hands in the air.	
How are jelly and cake the same?	They are both eaten for pudding/dessert. They are both cold. You can get different flavoured jelly and different flavoured cakes.	
Find something to use this for. (adult to point to the knife)	The cake. The knife can be used to cut the cake.	
Find the foods that are not fruit.	Sandwiches, crisps, jelly, burgers, sausage rolls and cake.	
How do you make a sandwich?	Wash hands. Gather the ingredients. Butter the bread. Put in the filling. Put the other buttered slice of bread on top. Cut the sandwich with a knife.

What could the girl say?	Anything that is relevant to a hirthday party scane of a "What a loyaly cake"
