

# Present Perfect Progressive

Present Perfect Progressive, also known as Present Perfect Continuous, describes events which started at some point in the past that may not be finished.

I **have been** baking

I **haven't been** baking

**Have** I **been** baking?

you **have been** baking (singular)

you **haven't been** baking

**Have** you **been** baking?

he/she/it **has been** baking

he/she/it **hasn't been** baking

**Has** he/she/it **been** baking?

Example:

we **have been** baking

we **haven't been** baking

**Have** we **been** baking?

you **have been** baking (plural)

you **haven't been** baking

**Have** you **been** baking?

they **have been** baking

they **haven't been** baking

**Have** they **been** baking?
