B: Yes, I have two brothers and one sister.

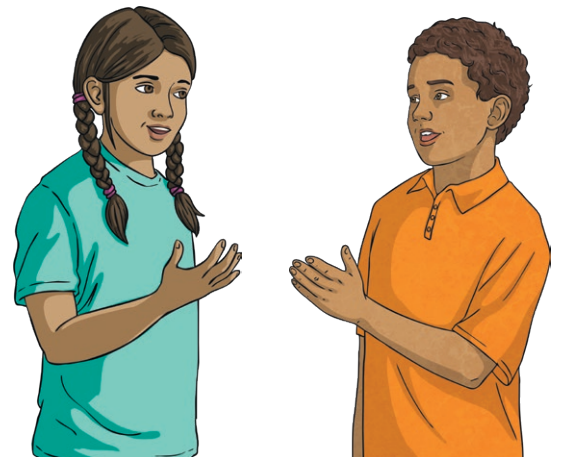
A: Nice to meet you.

B: Yes, I have two brothers and one sister and you?

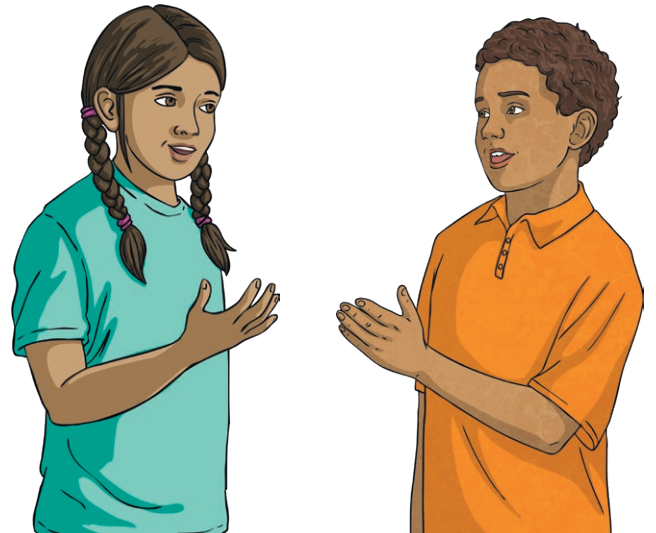
A: No, I'm an only child. Nice to meet you.
